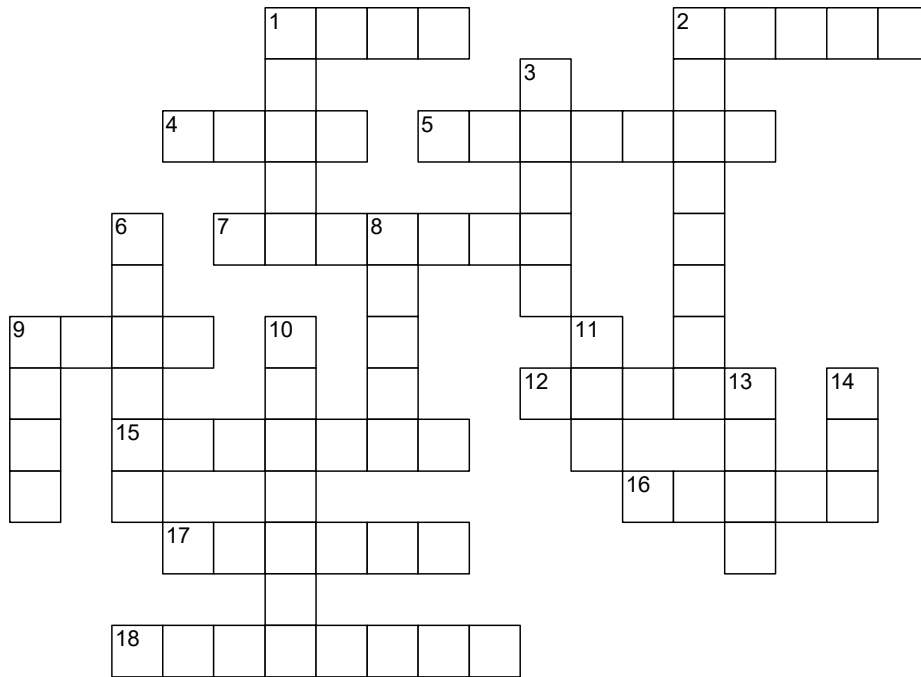


Shepherd and Sheep

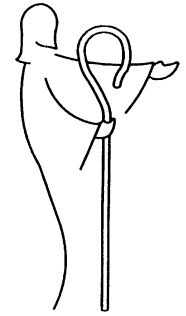
